

## Proclamation

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Body of the City of Hooks, Texas has decided to postpone the General Election until November 3, 2020 due to Governor Abbott's Proclamation signed March 18, 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, the confirmation of the candidate filings for the election will remain valid for the election held on the November Election date and the filing period will not be re-opened for the November Election date; and

**WHEREAS**, the confirmation of all ABBMs (Application for Ballots by Mail) for voters that are voting by mail due to being over the age of 65 or due to disability will still be valid for the postponed election, and of the ABBMs for voters who submitted ABBMs based on expected absence from the county would not be valid for the postponed election; and

**WHEREAS**, the new relevant dates for the November Election are as follows; Registration Deadline- October 5, 2020, submit ABBM- October 23, 2020, Early Voting- October 19-October 30, 2020.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it resolved that I, Jimmy Cochran, Mayor of the City of Hooks, do hereby proclaim November 3, 2020 the new temporary Election Date.
