


CITY OF HOOKS

July 18, 2022 Regular Business Meeting Minutes



1. The regular Business Meeting was Called to order by Mayor Reiter at 6:00pm.
2. The Invocation was led by Judge Les Colley and the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mayor Reiter.
3. Consent Agenda Items- Motion was made by Councilperson Felty and seconded by Councilperson Wright to approve the consent agenda items as presented, the motion was carried by a unanimous vote.
4. Open Forum/Public Comments- N/A
5. Consent agenda item on approving the 2022-2023 TML Health Insurance options. Councilperson Felty went over the numbers with Council and stated that Option 2 was in the best interest of the City. Councilperson Cochran made a motion to accept Option 2 and Councilperson Stoker seconded the motion. During discussion Councilperson Stoker stated that the insurance is very good and with the prices going up on everything, this was a good choice. Councilperson added to that with the increase we as the Council, need to be mindful of this expense when going over our Budget. With nothing further, the motion was carried by a unanimous vote.
6. Consent agenda item-consider and take action on Resolution 2022-07-18, allowing MVBA to collect the collection fee for past due utility bills. Mayor Reiter asked City Secretary Whitney Hale, to explain. She explained that currently the City insures that fee and with this Resolution it will be past onto the Customer in their collection of past due utility bills. Councilperson Felty motions to accept Resolution 2022-07-18 with Councilperson Cochran seconding the motion. With nothing further, the motion was carried by a unanimous vote.
7. Consent agenda item filling Council place 4, no action was taken and discussion was to reach out to the community to see if anyone was interested, a request was made by Councilperson Cochran to post on Facebook. With nothing further, Councilperson Cochran motioned to table this agenda item until next month. Councilperson Felty seconded and the motion was carried by a unanimous vote.
8. Remarks from the Mayor-Mayor Reiter states that he feels the City is moving in the right direction and that we have made a new hire in the Maintenance Department. The Home Grant homes are progressing and we are excited about that. Construction on the Waste Water Treatment Plant has been postponed again and we are expecting to start construction now, in August.
9. Adjournment- With nothing further Councilperson Felty made a motion to adjourn, Councilperson Wright seconded. Motion was carried by a unanimous vote. Meeting adjourned at 6:20pm
