


CITY OF HOOKS

February 14, 2022 Regular Meeting Minutes

1. The Council Meeting was called to order by Mayor, Marc Reiter at 6:00 PM and Members Felty and Phillips were absent.
2. The Invocation was led by Judge Les Colley and the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Councilperson Wright.
3. Consent Agenda Items-Motion was made by Councilperson Wright and seconded by Councilperson Murchison to approve the consent agenda items as presented.
4. Open Forum/Public Comments. Ms. Hughes signed up to speak about the creek that runs behind her house and the Cemetery. She is seeking help on cleaning that up to help with the drainage issue in that area. There is a lot of debris in the creek including railroad ties. Mayor addressed her concerns and stated that he will try to get in touch with the Railroad Commission.
5. Recommend and Approving the City to Order the Election for the General Election to be held on May 7, 2022 for Council Place 3 and 5 and the Mayor position. Motion was made by Councilperson Cannon and seconded by Councilperson Wright. Motion was carried by a unanimous vote.
6. Consent Agenda Item on the Interlocal Agreement-Councilperson Wright made a motion to on the Interlocal Agreement with Bowie County for the joint election. Councilperson Murchison seconded and the motion was carried by a unanimous vote.
7. Listened to Ashley Boyles with the Home Grant, on hiring Graco Homes as Contractor for four (4) additional houses to be built in Hooks. Councilperson Cannon made the motion and was seconded by Councilperson Wright. Motion carried by a unanimous vote.
8. Consent Agenda Item on the TXCDBG grant- Motion was made by Councilperson Wright on approving RESOLUTION NO 2-14-2022 on applying for the TXCDBG Planning/Capacity Building Fund. Motion was seconded by Councilperson Cannon. Motion was carried by a unanimous vote.
9. Adjournment-With a few remarks from Mayor, Reiter, on the redistricting the City of Hooks to District 4 and speaking to Congress person Pat Falon on his concerns not having a voice with being with such a big district. We had a motion made by Councilperson Wright and seconded by Councilperson Murchison, the motion was carried by a unanimous vote and the meeting adjourned at 6:20pm
