1. The Council Meeting was called to order by Mayor, Marc Reiter at 6:00 PM with Member Phillips and Cannon, being absent.

3. Consent Agenda Items-Motion was made by Councilperson Felty and Seconded by Councilperson Wright to approve the consent agenda items as presented, the motion was carried by a unanimous vote.
4. Open Forum/Public Comments. Listened to Ms. Hughes' recommendation on The Council giving progress reports on items discussed in Council Meetings, like the Smoke Testing the City had done. Mayor Reiter explained that she could come in and ask the office or any Council member about said items for updates. He also stated that we may be able to come up with a way to give updates in future meetings.
