



The City of Hooks has been informed that River Bend and Live Oak will be increasing the rates for which they charge the city. As a result, the City of Hooks has no choice but to increase water and trash rates to keep up with the rising prices. Therefore, the City of Hooks will be increasing its water and trash rates beginning with the monthly bill that will be mailed out to customers in November, due in December.

Please see below for the breakdown of the new water rates.

INSIDE CITY LIMITS

Water: up to 2000 gallons \$29.00 Per 1000 gallons over: \$9.00
Sewer: up to 2000 gallons \$22.50 Per 1000 gallons over: \$9.00
Trash: \$20.50
Tax: \$1.69
Total Bill: \$73.69

OUTSIDE CITY LIMITS

Water: up to 2000 gallons \$33.50 Per 1000 gallons over: \$10.30
Sewer: up to 2000 gallons \$25.15 Per 1000 gallons over: \$10.30
Trash: \$26.50
Tax: \$2.19
Total Bill: \$87.34

Outside city limits trash service will also see an increase.
